Protecting the environment from electronic pollution

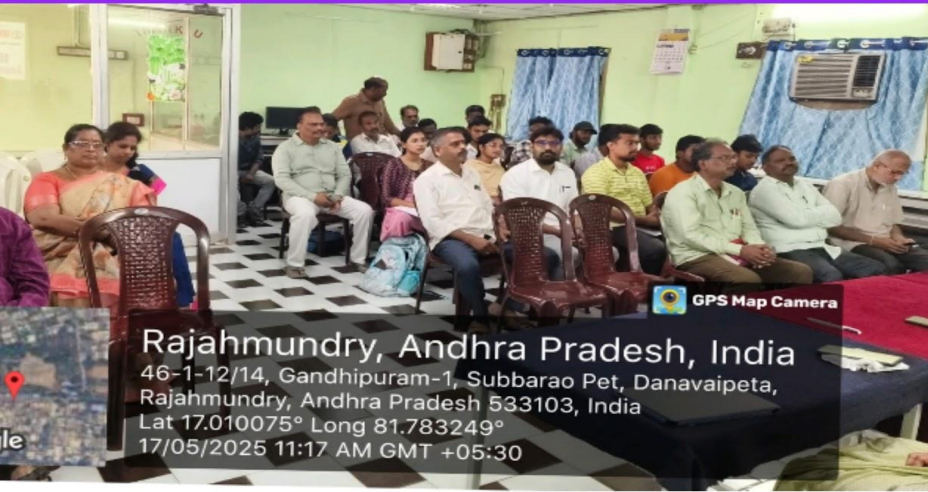

Maintaining a healthy and clean community environment

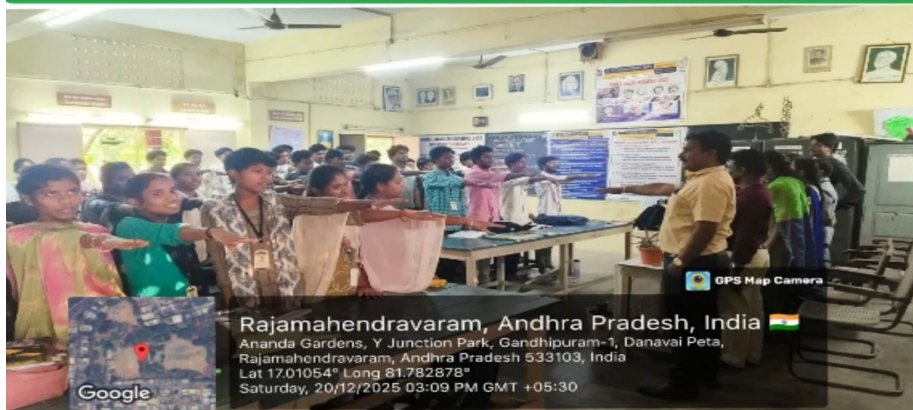
Preventing diseases through hygienic practices, Encouraging students to follow healthy lifestyle habits. The
